

# Welcome

Our Nursery childcare at Hope Lutheran Church exists to demonstrate God's love for children and then to families.

Our Goal is to provide a safe, sanitary, and loving environment while parents and or guardians attend church.



## Registration and Identification

All children are signed in with a contact number for the parents. The same person must pick up the child after the service.

All nursery volunteers are from our church and have each successfully passed a background check.

Hope Lutheran has a safety team called the Guardians of Hope. They watch our property during services to ensure safety. Our nursery childcare is housed in our Fellowship Hall adjacent to the church. We are continually monitored by the safety team in case of any problems with children.

# Health policy

To ensure the safety and well-being of each child we ask that you follow these "well child only" guidelines:

Please have consideration for your child if they are not feeling well and err on the side of caution for the health and safety of all children, nursery staff and for your peace of mind

Here is a list of illnesses:

- Fever, diarrhea, vomiting
- Runny nose with green or yellow discharge
- Bad coughing
- Pus, redness or crusting in eye
- Questionable rash
- Any common children's communicable diseases



## What to Bring

Bottle (if needed)
Sippy cup if your child can't use a regular cup
Snacks - Goldfish, Cheerios, graham crackers. Although, we will serve a snack so please make staff aware of allergies (on the sign in sheet)

We will text you if your child

- Is crying continually 10 minutes
- Gets an injury
- Becomes ill during service
